Dear Teacher Certification Candidates:

In order for you to complete teacher certification requirements at Queens College (other than finishing your teacher preparation program) you must also complete <u>5</u> seminars.

- 1. Child Abuse, Prevention and Intervention
- 2. School Violence Prevention and Intervention
- 3. School Safety (which consists of Fire and Arson, Child Abduction, and Safety on the Highways),
- 4. Alcohol and Substance Abuse.
- 5. <u>Dignity for All Students Act Seminar</u> Harassment, Bullying, and Discrimination Prevention and Intervention.

## **NOTE:** The (NEW) Harassment, Bullying, and Discrimination Prevention and Intervention Seminar is required of ALL candidates applying for Initial / Provisional / Professional / Permanent certification starting this Fall 2013.

## **Seminar Requirements by Program**

- Bachelor's Degrees (FIRST INITIAL CERTIFICATION) Complete all 5 seminars before the last semester in your program.
- Post Bachelor's Advanced Certificate Programs (FIRST INITIAL CERTIFICATION) Complete all 5 seminars before the last semester in your program.
- Master's Degrees. Required seminars are based upon the program you are completing.
  - 1. If your Master's Degree leads to the FIRST CERTIFICATION including **School Psychology, School Counseling,** and **School Building Leader** you will have to take all 5 seminars listed above.
  - 2. If your Master's Degree is for a second certification, the required seminars are based on your program.
    - If you are initially certified through a university **OTHER** than Queens College, you must take the **School Safety Seminar** and the **Harassment**, **Bullying**, and **Discrimination Intervention and Prevention Seminar**.
    - Please note: The <u>AUTISM SEMINAR IS NOT REQUIRED</u> if you are completing the <u>MSED Programs</u> in Students with Disabilities either Early Childhood – Birth-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Childhood Grades 1-6, or the Generalist 7-12 W/Extension
- **Post Master's Advanced Certificate Programs** Required seminars are based on the program you are completing.
  - 1. If you are Initially Certified through a university **OTHER** than Queens College, you must take the **School Safety Seminar** and the **Harassment**, **Bullying**, and **Discrimination Prevention and Intervention Seminar**.
  - Please note that the <u>AUTISM SEMINAR IS REQUIRED</u> if you are completing the <u>Post Masters Advanced</u> <u>Certificate Programs</u> in Students with Disabilities either Early Childhood – Birth-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, Childhood Grades 1-6, or the Generalist 7-12 W/Extension
